## OAKLAND COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #5 OAKLAND, IL Waiver Hearing November 14, 2012

The Board of Education of Oakland Community Unit District #5 of Coles, Douglas, and Edgar Counties convened for a waiver hearing in the Lake Crest Elementary School at 6:45 p.m. on November 14, 2012.

The meeting was called to order by President Clifton at 6:45 p.m. with members: Buckler, Butler, Clifton, Dague, Hudson, McKinney, and Pearcy present. Also present were Supt. Landeck and Paul Hinson.

A motion was made by Dague, seconded by Pearcy to approve the Agenda as Presented. Upon roll, all members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Landeck explained the purpose for pursuing the waiver. The district was seeking approval from the Illinois General Assembly to exceed the 5% limit on administrative costs. Landeck explained that the district was not actually exceeding the limit. However, in order to correct past practices on how expenses are reported to ISBE on the budget, it appears that the limit is being exceeded. In reality, it is not. It simply appears that way because funds are being moved from one line to another on the budget.
